



Amano Christian School - Homework Policy Primary

1. Aim

Homework is to be set to reinforce work covered in class and to give the students an opportunity to do research and to prepare for further study or tests.

2. Organization and supervision

To take home:

- All students should take a reading book home 3 times a week
- Students in Grades 2 - 7 should be given Spelling lists and Maths calculations each week.
- Grade 1 will have Spellings from term 3.
- Library book
- Any student can be given unfinished class work, as necessary
- All work taken home should be signed by the parents to ensure there is good communication concerning such activities.
Books are provided for recording reading progress of students in Grades 1 - 7. These should be completed by the teacher and signed by the adult at home who heard the child read.
- All work will be marked or tested by the class teacher.

No work taken home should take more than 30 minutes in one evening, by the teacher's estimation.

To do at school:

- Grades 4 - 7 have homework given at the teachers discretion and should not take more than 30 minutes by their estimation.
- Grade 6 & 7 will have one homework task set per week in term 3 in order to prepare them for Secondary school.
- All work will be marked or tested by the class teacher.
