

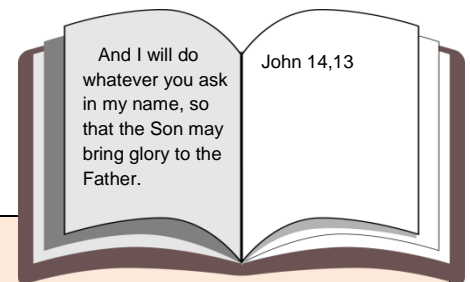

ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS:

Reminder to always excuse any absence from school in writing

Thank you to all who have been doing this faithfully. Students are recorded as unexcused if the school office (office@amanocs.org) has not received a written apology from parents/guardians (by e-mail or letter) giving an acceptable reason at the latest two days after the student was absent or partly absent from school. The number of unexcused absences will be shown in their report at the end of term. If a test/exam is written, a doctor's note is needed in addition, otherwise the test can be assessed with an F.

Leave of absence (e.g. at the end or at the beginning of term) will only be granted by the headteacher when it is requested at least one week in advance in written form (by e-mail or letter) and acceptable reasons are given. Otherwise absences – with no or late notices – will be recorded as unexcused.
